to SME Declaration



Enterprise Portal for Jobs and Skills (EPJS) is the **one-stop portal** for Enterprises to explore information and resources on relevant **jobs and skills initiatives** under SkillsFuture Singapore (SSG) and Workforce Singapore (WSG).

Small Medium Enterprise (SME) Declaration will be a digital service in EPJS for Enterprises to declare their SME status if applicable*.

*Please note that for enrolments for course runs with a start date of 1 November 2020 onwards, your SME status will be derived from government data and the applicable SME funding will be accorded. Also, your SME Status may refresh at the end of each calendar year. Please submit your declaration of SME status in EPJS only if you find your SME status is inaccurate.

The EPJS is a website for the public. Only users with the **assigned Corppass credentials** will be able to log in and transact within the portal.

setting up corppass

If you are **not** the Corppass Administrator, you will need to approach your organisation's Corppass Administrator for assignment of Corppass to access EPJS.



Actions Required by your Organisation's Corppass Administrator:

1. Login to Corppass website at www.corppass.gov.sg.
2. Select 'SSG-WSG E-SERVICES' under "SKILLSFUTURE SINGAPORE AGENCY"
3. Assign at least one user to the role **EPJS ENTERPRISE USER**.
4. Assigned user(s) will be able to submit SME Declaration. This role should be assigned to the employee who manages the transactions with SSG and WSG.

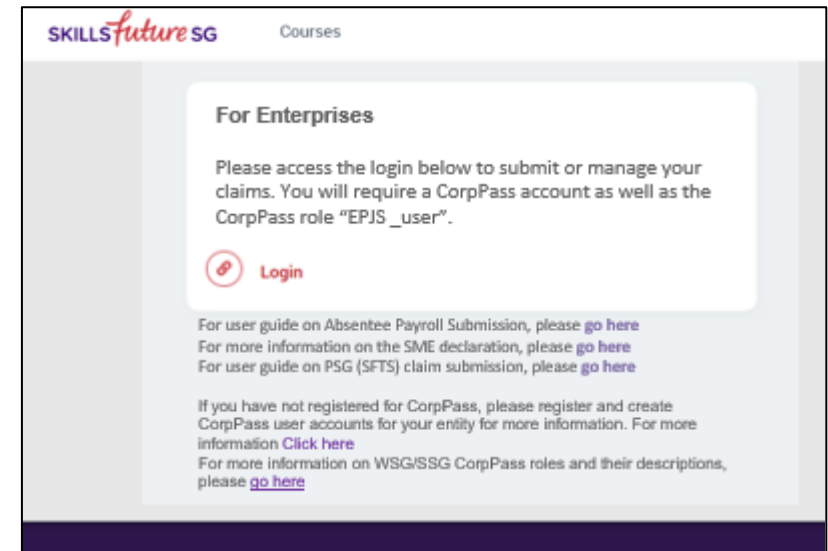

Upon logging in EPJS, **Enterprises will need to click on the SME Status tab**, where they will be directed to their unique dashboard, to submit the SME declaration as well as check on the status of any previously submitted SME declarations.

Upon clicking the “+” button, you will be directed to the **SME Declaration Page**.

Tip

In the **SME Declaration** and **Supporting Documents** sections, you will be able to:

- Enter Ownership, Employment Size, and Annual Sales Turnover
- Upload all the required documents (i.e. ACRA document, CPF90 with breakdown of local vs foreign employees, financial statements and any other relevant documents) to enable SSG to award the correct funding based on the SME definition.

Things To Note

- This SME declaration takes about 5 minutes to be completed.
- Accepted file formats include GIF, JPEG, JPG, PNG, PDF.
- Please ensure that you have all the information below to complete the SME Status Declaration.
 - Employment Size (Includes anyone employed under a contract of service according to the Employment Act. This is regardless of the nationality of the employee).
 - Annual Sales Turnover (Revenue or sales turnover stated in the company's income statement).

i. A company qualifies for the Enhanced Training Support under the SME scheme if it meets the following criteria:

- Company must be registered or incorporated in Singapore; AND
- Employment size of not more than 200; OR Annual sales turnover of not more than S\$100 million.
- Ministries, statutory boards, and other government agencies are not eligible under the Enhanced Training Support for SMEs scheme.

ii. You can submit a request on this page to review your organisation's SME status. Please note that any amendments will only apply for claims made after the SME status of your organisation is approved. There will also not be changes made to grants disbursed to your organisation, prior to the approval of the SME status of your organisation.

iii. To ensure that your organisation is awarded the correct funding based on the SME definition, please ensure that the Ownership, Employment Size and Annual Sales Turnover of your company profile are accurate and up to date.

iv. Please upload all the required documents (i.e. ACRA document, CPF90 with breakdown of local vs foreign employees, financial statements and any other relevant documents) to enable us to award the correct funding based on the SME definition. The review will be made based on these documents that have been submitted to us.

Frequently Asked Questions on SME Declaration

frequently asked questions

SME Declaration

Q: What is a Small Medium Enterprise (SME)? How does it relate to the eligibility for Enhanced Training Support under the SME scheme?

A: A company qualifies for the Enhanced Training Support under the SME scheme if it meets the following criteria:

- Registered or incorporated in Singapore; and
- Employment size of not more than 200 or with annual sales turnover of not more than S\$100 million¹.

Footnotes:

1. The SME status will be derived from government data and the applicable SME funding will be accorded if eligible. Enterprises that find their SME status to be inaccurate may submit a declaration of SME status via Digital Services at the [Enterprise Portal for Jobs and Skills \(EPJS\)](#).

This scheme is intended for all organisations, including non-business entities not registered with ACRA e.g., VWOs, societies, etc. Only Ministries, statutory boards, and other government agencies are not eligible under Enhanced Training Support for SMEs Scheme. Sole proprietorships which meet all of the above criteria are also eligible.
